
Our Mission


- The life of religion is to reject what is bad as an offense to God and to do what is good for His sake.

Our Philosophy of Education

• Knowledge and self-discipline form the only solid basis for receiving the love and wisdom that flow in from God. We strive to impart that knowledge and teach that discipline

in ways that inspire and open up the children's minds.

- We encourage students to think for themselves based on the natural, moral and spiritual principles that will prepare them for a life of useful service on earth and in heaven.
- We work together with our parents every day to help their children achieve the greatest possible potential in every aspect of life.



Our Program

- We offer small, multi-grade classrooms from Jr. kindergarten through tenth grade.
- We begin each day with homeroom worship or a chapel service.
- Our program is rigorously academic. We work hard to meet the needs of all students. However, we have

limited resources for special needs children.



- We offer a full curriculum which includes religious studies, performance and visual arts, computer literacy, languages, music and physical education.
- Our church inspired curriculum integrates national standards with distinctive spiritual beliefs.

- We use the IOWA Test of Basic skills each year to ensure that our students are at or above the national standard grade levels.
- Historically our average test results have been consistently outstanding.



Tuition Information

Tuition for the 2016-2017 school year is \$7,000* (+ \$300 materials fee grades 7-10). In addition we encourage parents to contribute in anyway they can by sharing their talents with our students and their skills at work parties or chaperoning for trips.

- A non-refundable new student application fee of \$50 must accompany each new application. Applications are due by April 29 for grades 1-9 and by August 1 for Jr.K/K.
- A 9-month payment contract is available.

When you apply you will be provided with a WNC School Handbook. Once enrolled you will receive the school's weekly "e" Newsletter, "The ECHO" (our monthly church newsletter) and calendar of events.

We ask all parents who are new to the church to attend a short series of introductory classes about our unique Christian perspective. While we do not require church attendance of anyone, we do ask that you attend a least a few services with us (Sundays @ 11:00 AM) before enrolling your child to hear the teachings applied to life and to get to know other parents and members in this community.

*Please note: In order to provide this education at an affordable cost the Washington New Church Trustees set tuition at approximately half the actual annual cost.
