

WNCS SCHOOL SUPPLY LISTS 2016-2017

The following lists of supplies are to be purchased by the parents or students and are to be brought with them on the first day of school. Many of the following supplies run out or wear out during the course of a year. The school does not provide these supplies for student use. See that your child is resupplied when necessary.

JR. K & Kindergarten: (Please label everything - every pencil/crayon/marker - with your child's name)

Pkg. of #2 pencils (made of WOOD not composite)

A backpack or other school bag (at least 10" X 18")

- (1) box (16) crayons
- (6) Glue Sticks
- (1) Pair of scissors (prefer Fiskars kids sharp point)

Small water bottle – no-spill, **flip-up top** (not necessary to unscrew to drink) no taller than 8"

- (2) Boxes of facial tissues
- (1) Blanket (for "books and blankets" time) throw size labeled with name
- (1) Ruler

NOTE: A complete change of clothes including socks and underwear... does not need to be uniform -for personal emergencies.

- (1) Box (doz.) #2 pencils (made of **WOOD** not composite) Sharpened
- (1) Box 16 or more crayons
- (1) Block eraser pink*
- (1) pkg. pink eraser caps*
- (1) (Small) supply box
- (1) Pair of scissors
- (1) Bottle Elmer's washable/school glue
- (5) Pocket folders (with fasteners) different colors
- (1) **Large** box Kleenex to share with the class
- (1) Box colored pencils
- (1) Reusable Water bottle

Optional: If your child has a blanket they want to keep at school for reading time, they can bring it in. No Markers, Please!

- (2) Pkgs. of washable markers, one fat and one thin pack
- (1) 16 oz. Bottle of tacky glue
- (1) Pair of scissors
- (1) Pencil box
- (3) Glue sticks
- (4) Pocket folders (with fasteners)
- (1) 3 ring binder with pocket in front $(2" 2 \frac{1}{2}")$ no bigger please)
- (1) Box of colored pencils
- (1) Large box (or more to share) of facial tissue
- (3) Marbled composition books wide ruled
- (1) Hand held *all metal* pencil sharpener
- (1) Package dividers, 5 subjects

- (2) Big boxes of Kleenex
- (1) Pair of scissors
- (1) ea. Metric ruler, protractor & compass
- (1) pkg. Colored markers
- (1) pkg. eraser caps (pink)*
- (1) Block Eraser*
- (1) Composition book (writing journal)
- (1) Bottle of "White Out" (optional)

- (1) Assignment book
- (1) Hand operated pencil sharpener, good quality

The following supplies may need to be replenished as needed during the year:

Black or blue pens

200 – 400 sheets of college rule notebook paper (for all courses)

Pencils, mechanical or wood, not composite

Any other supplies the student deems necessary or helpful for good organization

(For Mrs. Waelchli's Math) (1) Metric ruler, (1) Protractor, (1) Compass (this is for home use; school compasses cannot leave the bldg.

(9/10 English for Mrs. Sprinkle):

(1) 3-ring binder (1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " - 2"), Paper – lots of it, Pens & Pencils

(9/10 Religion from Mr. Smith): Access to a NKJ Bible at home and some space in a classroom binder
