#### GENERAL INFORMATION ABOUT TUITION

Tuition rates cover approximately half of the actual educational costs for each student. The balance of the costs is paid through generous subsidies and donations to the school. Providing quality educations requires the dedicated services of a professional staff and resources, and tuition is essential to cover a portion of these expenses.

Tuition invoices along with payment plan forms and other important information will be sent to parents electronically by email (and by regular mail if requested) in July.

### WHEN FEES AND TUITION ARE DUE:

# 1. April 29<sup>th</sup> Application and Registration Fee

New applications must be accompanied by a non-refundable fee of \$50.00. All applications are due by **April 29**<sup>th</sup>. (Jr. K and K applications will be accepted through Aug 1<sup>st</sup>).

### 2. Mid-July Receive Tuition Information Packet

Tuition information packet includes details about methods for payment and form for applying for an alternative payment plan. Call if you do not receive your packet.

# 3. August 1<sup>st</sup> Alternative Payment Plan Application

If you do not plan to pay tuition in full you must submit an application for an alternative payment plan along with 10% of the tuition bill by August 1<sup>st</sup>.

# 4. August 15<sup>th</sup> Full Tuition and/or Approved Payment Plan

Either the full year's tuition  $\underline{OR}$  an *approved* "alternative payment plan" is due by Aug  $15^{th}$ . In addition to your approved alternative payment plan, a second 10% of your tuition will be required by August  $15^{th}$  (bringing the total pre-paid tuition to 20%).

# 5. Sept 30<sup>th</sup> First Monthly Payment Due

Payments of 10% are due by the end of the month with the first one due by Sept  $30^{th}$  and the final payment due by April  $30^{th}$ .

## WAYS TO PAY TUITION INCLUDING ALTERNATIVE PAYMENT PLANS

1. Tuition may be paid by check, credit card or pre-authorized withdrawals processed through the e-giving website<sup>3</sup>. The *preferred* payment *method* is by automatic monthly payments through e-giving. This method is easy to manage *and* it avoids the higher fees charged to the school for processing credit card payments.

### 2. Alternative Payment Plans (APP's)

- a. In lieu of payment of tuition in full by August 15, an applicant/re-applicant can apply for an *APP* using the *form* included in the tuition materials sent in July. The application must be submitted by Aug 1<sup>st</sup> in order to be considered.
- b. Once approved, an *APP* must be signed and turned in to the school office (a scan or photo of the signed form is acceptable).
- c. A request for an APP WILL NOT be considered unless it is accompanied by the required minimum deposit of 10% of the total tuition bill for the upcoming school year.<sup>4</sup>
- d. An applicant may apply for a standard APP (20% before August 15<sup>th</sup>, followed by 8 monthly payments of 10% Sept-April) or propose a different installment plan, provided that 20% of the tuition is still received by Aug 15<sup>th</sup> and the payment in full of all tuition is received by April 30<sup>th</sup> of the school year.
- e. When an APP has been approved, the treasurer will send monthly email reminders showing the status of payments against that Plan. Failure of the treasurer to send a reminder does not excuse any required payment.
- 3. **Prorated Tuition:** In the event that a student is enrolled less than a full year, tuition will be prorated by multiplying the number of calendar months that the student is enrolled by 1/9th of the annual tuition charge. Additional adjustments to tuition will be considered on a caseby-case basis.

# Non-Payment and Enforcement Policies

- 1. If tuition payments are in arrears compared to *APP*, academic records will not be released or disclosed to any person or entity until payments once against meet an agreed upon payment schedule. Such "academic records" include, but are not limited to, report cards, transcripts, electronic grade reports (Engrade), diplomas, and parent/teacher conferences.
- 2. Non-payment of tuition by more than a month compared to the approved *APP* may lead to notice followed by expulsion from the *current* school year.
- 3. Non-payment of tuition for a student at the end of the current school year disqualifies the student for re-admission for the following school year.
