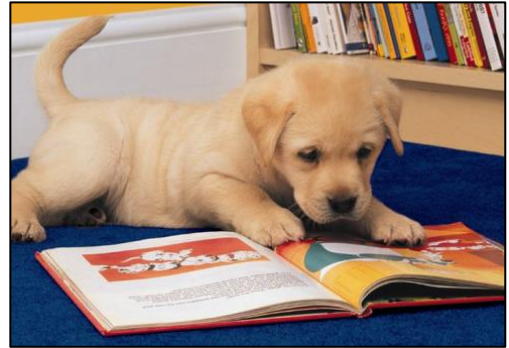


1st and 2nd Grade Summer Reading
