| 2. | You shall not take the name of the Lord your God in vain.... | "Hallowed be Thy name." |
| 3. | Remember the Sabbath Day to keep it holy.... | "Thy kingdom come." |
| 4a. | Honor your Father.... | "Thy will be done," |
| 4b. | Honor your mother.... | "As in heaven so upon the earth." |
| 5. | You shall not commit murder. | "Give us this day our daily bread." |
| 6. | You shall not commit adultery. | "And forgive us our debts, as we also forgive our debtors." |
| 7. | You shall not steal. | "And lead us not into temptation," |
| 8. | You shall not bear false witness against your neighbor. | "But deliver us from evil." |
| 9. | You shall not covet your neighbor's house. | "For Thine is the kingdom" |
| 10. | You shall not covet your neighbor's wife, manservant, maidservant, ox, donkey or anything that is your neighbor's | "And the power, and the glory, forever, Amen." |
